

# Kai Oni Wins Regatta

Kai Oni edged Waikiki Surf Club by three points to win the Kamehameha Day canoe races yesterday off Kailua beach.

A crowd of 2,000 lined the beach to watch the Hawaiian Canoe Racing Association-directed regatta.

Kai Oni scored 36 points to 33 for Waikiki Surf Club. Lanikai took third place with 14

points, barely nosing out Lanikai and Hui Nalu, tied at 13 for fourth place.

THE WSC MEN'S senior team bettered the 2-mile record of 19:11.2 set by Kai Oni in 1957, paddling the distance in 18:41.4.

Making up the record breaking crew were Joseph Napoleon, James Koko,

Randy Chun, Joseph Keahiolalo, Dutchy Kino and Blue Makua.

The regatta honored George A. Perry, coach of the Lanikai Canoe Club.
