

Waikiki Canoe Crews Win Macfarlane Races

Waikiki Surf Club swept to victories in six out of 12 races at the annual Walter Macfarlane Memorial Canoe Regatta at Waikiki Saturday to walk off with the team championship.

The Waikiki paddlers nipped the Outrigger Canoe Club by one point, 32-31, for the title with Kai Oni coming in third with 24 points. Healani finished fourth with 14 and Lanikai fifth with 13 points.

The W.S.C. crews captured both the men and women senior events. The women senior six, the day's final event, was won with a team of Margaret Hipa, Ruby Kalama, Anona Naone, Frieda Shephard, Helen DeFries and Keala Stibbard.

They topped the Outrigger crew in 9:02.

Dutchy Kino, Randy Chun, James Koko, Joe Napoleon, Conrad Cunha and Blue Makua made up the winning men's senior six for the Waikiki team, capturing the two-mile race in 26 minutes and 44 seconds.

Waikiki Surf took the boys 15 and 17 events, and Outrigger posted wins in the boys 14 and freshmen races.
