

# Outrigger Canoe Club Captures Oahu Crown

Outrigger Canoe Club easily won the Oahu Canoe Racing Championships yesterday at Keehi Lagoon.

The George Downing-coached paddlers won five races of the 11-event program to score 40 points.

Kai Oni finished second with 29 points followed by Waikiki Surf Club, 25; Healani, 10; Hui Nalu, 9; Lanikai, 7, and Holomua, 1.

Outrigger won the senior men's two-mile race with a record time of 16:51.0 as compared with its former standard of 17 minutes flat.

W.S.C.'s women's senior crew set another record in

winning the half-mile event in 4:49.0. The former record, also owned by W.S.C., was 5:05.7.
