

Sheraton^N Lists Expansion Plans

A tentative master plan for expansion of facilities at Sheraton Hawaii's four Waikiki Hotels was explained last night by Lloyd B. Carswell, Sheraton's vice president and general manager.

THE 38-POINT program includes four new hotels and dozens of new shops, parking

facilities, cocktail lounges and restaurants.

Many of the projects have been announced previously but more detailed plans were made available last night by Carswell for the first time.

PLANS INCLUDE the new

Diamond Head wing of the Royal Hawaiian Hotel with the first floor devoted to the Outrigger Canoe Club and the Uluniu Women's Swimming Club.

Other projects include a multi-deck parking garage at the Princess Kaiulani Hotel.

AMONG PROJECTS to be

completed next year are:

A two-story shop and office building on Royal Hawaiian frontage between McInerny's and the Snack Shop.

A new Crown Room restaurant in the Royal Hawaiian corridor leading to the Monarch Room, modeled aft-
