

OCC Asks For Permit To Build Pier

The Outrigger Canoe Club has applied for a Department of the Army permit to build a recreational pier and to dredge a swimming area at its new property adjoining the Elks Club on Kalakaua Ave.

The proposed pier will be 407 feet long, 10 feet wide, and have a deck elevation of eight feet above low tide water.

THE SWIMMING area will have an irregular shape of some 200 feet by 140 feet, dredged to a depth of 4.5 feet below low tide.

The dredged material is estimated at 2,500 cubic yards. It will be deposited on shore behind a rock wall to create a new beach.

ARMY ENGINEERS said approval will rest primarily upon the effect of the proposed work on navigation.

Any objections should be forwarded by Sept. 4 to Col. John R. Clifton, District Engineer.
