

Isle Canoeists Win California Race

NEWPORT BEACH, Calif. (UPI) — The Hawaiian All-Star outrigger paddling crew yesterday won the Catalina Island - to - Newport Dunes race against five other boats.

Last Sunday the Islanders lost a two-mile dash.

Although seven outriggers had been entered in the event, only six took part. Newport boat No. 1 did not start.

1; Marina Del Rey, and Balboa No. 2.
