

Elks Veto Dilco Proposal

Members of the Honolulu Elks Club overwhelmingly voted down—149 to 12—the Dillingham Corp. proposal to build a high-rise condominium apartment building and multi-level parking structure on the Elks' parking lot at 2933 Kalakaua Ave.

The project would not have disturbed the present Elks facilities there, and the multi-million-dollar development would have been at Dilco's expense.

But the proposal was rejected by the membership in part because of legal questions raised over the terms of the lease granted by the Elks to the Outrigger Canoe Club next door. The terms give the Outrigger rights of first refusal on the Elks property.

Also a number of members reportedly expressed questions of whether the Dilco proposal was the kind of development they wanted on the site.
