Outrigger Second In Volley Tourney

GRAND RAPIDS, Mich. (UPI)—Outrigger Canoe Club of Honolulu clinched second place in the National Collegiate volleyball championships here yesterday after losing two matches to the title winning Sand and Sea Club green team of Santa Monica, Calif.

Sand and Sea topped the Honolulu team, 14-12, 16-14, as the final round opened.

The Outrigger defeated Westside Jewish Community Center of Los Angeles, 15-1, 0-15, 15-1, in the finale of the

losers' bracket to remain in contention.

However, Sand and Sea again topped the Outriggers, 15-9, 15-13, in the title decider of the open division.

In taking second, Outrigger nabbed the highest ranking of any Hawaiian team to compete in the national tournament.

The Renegades of Los Angeles downed the defending women's champion, the Shamrocks of Long Beach, 15-9, for the womens' division title.
