

Transpac Race

Glass Slipper In First Place

Glass Slipper, skippered by Jay Johnson of Seal Beach, Calif., was leading the Transpacific catamaran race at the 5 a.m. report yesterday, it was announced by co-chairman Cline Mann of the Outrigger Canoe Club.

The pace-setter was 1,445 nautical miles out of Honolulu at roll call time. The Patty Cat II, skippered by Dr. John Purcell of Balboa,

Calif., was 1,500 miles from Honolulu.

Virtually in a dead heat, but 30 miles apart, were the Imaloa and Tri-Star, both 1,520 miles out of Honolulu. The World Cat was reported 1,555 miles away.

Poor wind conditions, average from 3 to 5 knots, have slowed down the boats and the first boat is now estimated to arrive next Wednesday. If the wind picks up the cats may finish earlier, Mann stated.

The five catamarans left Newport Beach for Honolulu last Saturday. The Outrigger and Waikiki Yacht Club are the co-sponsors.
