

World Cat Will Arrive Today

The World Cat, owned by Juergen Wagner of Hamburg, Germany, is scheduled to arrive some time today, according to latest reports received last night.

The Ima Loa crossed Diamond Head finish line at 10 o'clock last night to become the third boat to complete the Transpacific catamaran race which started last Saturday from San Pedro, Calif.

The World Cat is the only foreign entry in the five-boat race. The Tri-Star, a triple-hulled catamaran owned by Edward B. Horstman of Venice, Calif., is expected to

arrive tonight.

The Patty Cat II, skippered by Jack Swart, was the first craft to finish, crossing Diamond Head lighthouse at 4:30 p.m. Thursday, with an elapsed time of 12 days, 7 hours, 31 minutes and 28 seconds.

Winner on corrected time however, was the Glass Slipper, which finished 2 little over two hours later. Her corrected time was 11 days, 14 hours, 44 minutes and 8 seconds.

The second annual race was sponsored by the Waikiki Yacht Club and Outrigger Canoe Club.
