## Lowell Is Named Olympic Manager

John Lowell, athletic director at Church College of Hawaii, has been named manager of the U.S. National volleyball team for the Olympic Games in Mexico City, it was announced yesterday.

Word of Lowell's appointment was received by Bill Robinson, U.S. Volleyball Association commissioner for Hawaii.

At the same time, Robinson disclosed that Jon Stanley, a new member of the Outrigger Canoe Club's team, has been named the U.S. volleyball nominee for the Sullivan Award, annually given to the outstanding amateur athlete in the nation.

Lowell coached the Outrigger team to the National AAU championship last year. He was also manager of the U.S. team which captured the gold medal at the Pan American Games in Montreal last August.

Stanley, a graduate of Brigham Young University, is now studying for his master's degree at the University of Hawaii. He is also on the Service Center Hawaii team in the Armed Forces Basketball League.
