# U. S. Volleyball Stars Tangle

The Westside Jewish Community Center volleyball team, winner of eight straight tournaments this year in Southern California, tangles this week with the powerful Outrigger Canoe Club team.

And when the battles are over, officials for the Olympic Games will have a pretty good line on just where the talent lies in American volleyball circles.

The schedule is like this:

April 8 — Farrington High gym.

April 9 — Farrington High gym.

April 10 — Church College at Laie.

April 11-12-13 — The ninth annual Haili tournament at Hilo, where the two clubs are bound to meet.

The Jewish Center team has eight All-Americans of one sort or another playing on it.

These include such stars

as Larry Rundle and Wink Davenport, who played on the 1967 Pan-American Games team; and Mike Bright, an All-American who was on the Pan-Am team in 1963 and the Olympic games team in 1964.

However, the Hawaii club is stacked with greats, too, including Pete Velasco, member of the 1964 Olympics team; John Stanlee, and John Alstrom, all rated

among the greatest in the land.

"This undoubtedly is the best chance the people of Hawaii will have to see this type of powerful volleyball," says John Lowell, coach of the Outrigger club. "Both teams have trained extra hard and I am confident every player will be going all out in these exhibitions. Both coach Harlan Cohen of the visitors and myself expect to place a number of men on this year's Olympic squad."
