LA Slammers Defeat Outrigger

The Los Angeles Westsiders and Church College won their opening games of the ninth annual Haili Invitational Volleyball Tournament last night in the Piihonua Gym.

Central Y and the Leialohas of the Women's division also chalked up victories to stay in the winners' bracket.

net. The Rainbows had earlier defeated Lehua, 15-7, 15-6.
