

Canoe Regatta At Kailua

Four canoe clubs will race over the two-mile distance today in the Blue Ribbon Race of the 12-event Kamehameha Day Canoe Regatta at Kailua Beach. First event is 10 a.m.

Healani Canoe Club, the defending champion of the regatta, Hui Nalu, Outrigger and Waikiki Surf are the four in the main race.

A total of nine clubs are entered in the regatta, according to John P. Kapua Jr., race chairman. They are, in addition to those listed above, Kailua Hawaiian Civic, Kai Oni, Lanikai, Leeward Kai and Maile Son's.

The day's activities are co-sponsored by the Kamehameha Day Celebration Committee and the Hawaii Canoe Racing Association.

EVENTS — Quarter mile races for 13-year-olds, 14-year-olds, novice women. Half mile races for novice men, 16-year-olds, freshmen women and junior women. Mile-and-one-half race for junior men. One mile races for senior women, 18-year-olds and freshmen men. Two mile race for senior men.
