Thirteen canoes are poised for the annual Aloha Week Molokai to Oahu canoe race Sunday.

The race starts at Hale O Lono Harbor, Molokai, at 7:30 a.m. and will finish in front of the Hilton Hawaiian Village. Estimated arrival time of the first canoe is 1:30 p.m.
