

13 canoes competing

Thirteen outrigger canoes will start in Sunday's Molokai-to-Oahu race from Hale O Lono Harbor, Molokai, to the beach in front of the Hilton Hawaiian Village.

The first canoe is expected to finish six hours from the time the canoes leave Molokai at 7:30.

Kailua Hawaiian Civic Club set the record for the koa class, negotiating the 41 miles in 5 hours and 56 minutes in 1964, while Healani set the non-koa mark of 6 hours, 12 minutes and 14 seconds last year.
