

Waikiki Surf canoe winner

Waikiki Surf Club won the 19-mile ocean Waikiki-to-Po-kai Bay Canoe Challenge Race yesterday. Its time was 4 hours 8 minutes.

Hui Nalu captured first place in the women's race, triumphing in 4 hours 43 minutes over Kailua Hawaiian Civic Club, the only other entry.

Chris Faria was race director. He announced that the 21-mile Lanikai-Waikiki race will be held Sunday Aug. 29.

Eight clubs competed in yesterday's men's division race which was held in rough sea. One of three Healani canoes was swamped off Barbers Point and broke up, but the paddlers were safely taken off by a rescue boat.

With Waikiki Surf finishing first, Healani No. 1 was second, with the Outrigger Canoe Club crews finishing third and fourth. Kailua Hawaiian Civic Club was fifth, Leeward Kai sixth, Kai Oni seventh and Healani No. 2 eighth.
