

OCC Sweep for Campbell

The Navy's Bill Campbell, a three-time collegiate sailing All-American from Annapolis, Md., swept five straight races while winning the Outrigger Canoe Club regatta's largest single fleet—the 17-boat Laser dinghies—last Sunday off Waikiki.

"Campbell was uncanny off the wind," said Art Silcox, who finished third in the Laser division.

"He was so fast that no one could touch him, but the competition for the rest of us was tight. Only a few points separated the next five places."
