

# Favorites win in AAU volleyball

The favorites of the men and women volleyball teams performed as predicted to capture the Region 5 Hawaii A.A.U. Open Volleyball Championships held Friday night and yesterday at Klum Gym.

In the men's division, the Outrigger Canoe Club, boasting credentials of an Olympic representative team, trounced Chuck's Cellular, 15-7, 15-6, to win

the title.
