

Nick's, OCC Teams Advance

EL PASO, Tex. (AP)—The Nick's Fishmarket of Honolulu women's volleyball team—winners of last weekend's National AAU Championships at Arlington, Tex.—beat Lokahi of Los Angeles and the Columbus (Ohio) Juniors convincingly yesterday, to be rated the team to beat after first-day competition of the United States Volleyball Association Tournament at Memorial Gymnasium on the University

of Texas at El Paso campus.

Coached by University of Hawaii assistant coach Alan Kang, the Nick's team outlasted the Californians in the first game, 15-7, 14-16, 15-9, and thumped Columbus later, 15-3, 15-5.

In the men's open competition, Hawaii's Outrigger Canoe Club blasted Wright-Patterson Air Force Base, 15-3, 15-0 in a first-round match and then beat Western Illinois, 15-6, 15-7.
