

MEMPHIS, Tenn. — Hawaii's three men's teams advanced to the final day of competition, but the University of Hawaii Wahines will not defend their U.S. Volleyball Association women's open championship after losing in yesterday's 53rd USVBA nationals.

The men's open team of the Outrigger Canoe Club won its pool Thursday and was seeded fourth going into yesterday's play. The team lost to Nautilus Pacifica, a team of former U.S. national

players, but worked out of the losers' bracket to earn a match this morning with the Texas Stars.
