THE USA Men's Volleyball team's newest fundraiser is a 23-by-35-inch full-color poster of Tom Selleck in the team uniform holding a volleyball. His signature is printed in the lower right-hand corner, and the whole thing is yours for \$4.95 plus \$1 postage.
