

Harold Hustace

Harold P. "H.P." Hustace, 89, of Honolulu, died Tuesday at his home. He was the owner of Kaulaaha Ranch on East Molokai, a founder and charter member of the Outrigger Canoe Club.

Mr. Hustace was the last surviving son of Frank and Mellie Ward Hustace. He was a 32nd degree Mason. He was formerly a competitive swimmer and surfer, a member of the Olympic rough-water competition team of 1912. He was active in the Hawaii Cattlemen's Council.

Services over the ashes will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday at the Masonic Temple on Makiki Street. The ashes will be scattered offshore of the Outrigger Canoe Club at 11 a.m.

He is survived by his wife, Maria Hustace; and a son, Floyd.
