

# *Napili beo*

Napili of Maui edged Hui Nalu of Hawaii Kai by five seconds yesterday in the 10-mile women's race of the Loa'a Open Classic outrigger canoe race.

Napili traveled from Kailua Beach to Heeia Kea Pier in Kaneohe in one hour, 48 minutes, five seconds.

Lanikai, racing a fiberglass "bullet" (streamlined) canoe, won the 25-mile men's race from Magic Island to Kailua Beach. Lanikai was timed in 4:03:45, well ahead of second-place Lokahi (4:22:32).
