

TOMORROW, OUTRIGGER
Canoe Club hosts its sixth annual
Waikiki Ocean Paddleboard Race
—a 10,000-meter (6.2 miles) event
which starts and finishes at OCC.

"I expect 30-40 people to enter,"
said race director Dale Hope.

The race begins at 11 a.m. and
covers the waters between Dia-
mond Head Buoy and a marker
at the entrance of the Hilton
Hawaiian Village Hotel. Paddle-
boards must fall within a 12-foot
maximum length and weigh 20
pounds, or more. "There are no
other restrictions," Hope said.

Oahu's Bret Goodfriend, who
set the course record of one-hour,
12 minutes and 37 seconds two
years ago, will be among Hawaii's
top paddleboard entries.

"We'll take applications up to
10 a.m. on the day of the race,"
said Hope. "And best of all there
is no fee and everyone receives a
T-shirt."
